Red

Ciello Nero d'Avola 2024

Made in Sicily, where intense sunshine and cooling coastal winds create reds with both richness and freshness. Produced from Nero d'Avola, the island's signature grape, this wine is juicy and generous with flavours of dark cherry, plum and sweet spice, supported by soft tannins and a lively finish that keeps it bright and approachable.

Cantine Innocenti, Chianti Colli Senesi 2021

Comes from the southern hills of Tuscany around Siena, an area known for producing expressive, food-friendly styles of Chianti. Made predominantly from Sangiovese, it shows vibrant red berry fruit, dried herbs and hints of violet, with supple tannins and a savoury earthiness that gives the wine elegance and charm.

Cantine Innocenti, Vino Nobile di Montepulciano 2019

Produced in the medieval hilltop town of Montepulciano in Tuscany, where vineyards sit at higher elevations and benefit from warm days and cool evenings. Crafted from Prugnolo Gentile, the local clone of Sangiovese, it is layered and refined with notes of sour cherry, tobacco, cedar and dried spice, finishing with polished tannins and impressive depth.

Foradori, Teroldego 2023

Grown in the foothills of the Dolomites in Trentino, where dramatic alpine landscapes and biodynamic farming shape wines of purity and character. Produced from Teroldego, an indigenous northern Italian grape, it is vivid and deeply aromatic with blackberry, forest fruit and violet notes layered over earthy spice and silky tannins.

Caparsa, Rosso di Caparsa Toscana 2020

Originates in the rugged hills of Radda in Chianti, one of Tuscany's highest and coolest winemaking zones, renowned for producing wines of tension and finesse. Made mainly from Sangiovese, this expressive red combines wild red fruit, crushed herbs and subtle smoky notes, with bright acidity and a finely textured palate that unfolds gracefully in the glass.

Monte Dall' Ora, Valpolicella Camporengo 2022

Comes from the Valpolicella hills near Verona where traditional pergola-trained vineyards are surrounded by olive groves and woodland. Made primarily from Corvina, Corvinone and Rondinella, this organic red is fragrant and lifted, offering flavours of Morello cherry, dried rose and sweet spice, with a fresh, supple palate and remarkable elegance.

Casina Bric, Barolo 2016

Produced in Piedmont's Langhe hills, a UNESCO-listed landscape famed for some of Italy's most revered wines. Made from Nebbiolo, Barolo's noble grape, this wine is structured yet beautifully perfumed, revealing layers of red cherry, dried petals, liquorice and earthy spice, with firm tannins and a long, graceful finish.

White

Madregale Bianco Terre D'Abruzzo 2025

Produced along Italy's Adriatic coastline in Abruzzo, a region framed by mountain peaks and cooling sea air that lends brightness and balance to its wines. Made primarily from Trebbiano with some Chardonnay, this fresh and approachable white opens with notes of ripe orchard fruit, lemon zest and wild herbs, with a clean, rounded palate and a subtle mineral edge that keeps everything vibrant and refreshing.

San Marzino Trefili Pinot Grigio 2025

Produced in Veneto, the historic heartland of Pinot Grigio in north-east Italy where cooler conditions and gentle Adriatic influences help create wines with freshness and precision. Bright and lively in style, it shows notes of pear, citrus blossom and green apple, with a delicate floral character and a clean, zesty finish.

Antica Enotria Bianco 2025

From northern Puglia near the Gargano National Park, an area shaped by limestone soils, sea breezes and a long tradition of organic farming. A blend of Falanghina and Fiano, this vibrant white is textured yet energetic, offering notes of citrus oil, stone fruit and Mediterranean herbs with a savoury streak and gentle salinity that lingers beautifully.

Cinzia Bergaglio La Fornace Gavi di Tassarolo 2024

Grown in the hills of Piedmont in north-west Italy, where the Cortese grape thrives on mineral-rich soils around the historic commune of Gavi. Elegant and finely structured, it delivers aromas of white peach, citrus peel and acacia flower while the palate is crisp and refined with subtle almond notes and a stony freshness.

Sweet

La Stoppa, Vino del Volta 2024

Comes from Emilia-Romagna, where rolling vineyard slopes and warm autumn conditions are ideal for producing traditional passito wines. Made from Malvasia di Candia Aromatica grapes that are gently dried before fermentation, it is intensely fragrant and luxurious, with notes of apricot, orange peel, honey and exotic spice balanced by vibrant freshness and remarkable lift.

Sparkling

Rive della Chiesa Prosecco Frizzante NV

From the rolling hills of Veneto in north-east Italy, where cooler Alpine breezes help preserve freshness and delicacy in the grapes. Lightly sparkling and wonderfully easy-drinking, this Prosecco shows crisp green apple, pear skin and white blossom, finishing with a gentle citrus lift and a soft, lively mousse that makes it an ideal aperitif.
